




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VERY BEST OF ANTARCTICA - USHUAIA TO USHUAIA EXPEDITION

Celebrate the best that the Antarctic Peninsula has to offer - from towering icebergs and impressive glaciers to unreal wildlife encounters and fascinating historical sites. Get ready to spend your days blissfully exploring the hidden beauty of the white continent.



ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive in & Explore Ushuaia

After a friendly welcome at the airport and a transfer to the luxurious Arakur Resort & Spa, take some time to unwind or explore the southernmost city in the world, Ushuaia.

Our evening briefing at the Arakur is your opportunity to ask questions and meet some of your fellow explorers.

Day 2: Embarkation



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Spend your morning relaxing at the hotel, visiting a museum, or exploring the shops in Ushuaia, before our mid-afternoon escort to the ship. Our Expedition Team and ship staff will welcome you on board and get you settled in, followed by a safety and orientation briefing and our Captain's welcome dinner. We're on our way to Antarctica!

Day 3-4: Drake Passage

Join our Polar Experts as they share their vast knowledge of Antarctica, from its enchanting wildlife to its bold history. Participate in our pioneering Citizen Science program or sit back and take in this fabled journey while catching glimpses of rarely seen wildlife. Keep your binoculars handy to identify the many seabirds that escort our ship as we cross the Antarctic Convergence into Antarctica's waters and noticeably cooler temperatures.

Day 5-6: South Shetland Islands

Over time, the volcanic activity of the South Shetland Islands has created a geology unlike any other. Here, you can expect a spectacular display of mountains, glaciers, and wildlife including Chinstrap and Gentoo penguins; and it's not uncommon to share the water's edge with Elephant and Fur seals. Whales are often spotted as well. So, we'll settle into our Zodiacs and spend most of our day exploring. And kayakers, it's time to get your first taste of gliding just inches off the pristine Antarctic water. Whether on land or sea, in zodiac or kayak, be prepared for a fully immersive introduction to this incomparable part of the world.

Day 7-9: Antarctica

Welcome to Antarctica in all its awe-inspiring glory. For the next few days, we'll explore any number of picturesque bays and famed harbors, maneuvering through majestic channels, where glorious icebergs and an array of beguiling wildlife share the highly active waters. Prepare to be amazed as we spot numerous species of penguins, seals, and whales, both along the rugged coastline as well as in the sea. There are great opportunities to stop at several active scientific bases and historic landing sites, and we plan to take full advantage of all the continent offers.

Day 10-11: Drake Passage

We leave this magical place and make our way north, once again crossing the legendary Drake Passage. We have one last hurrah as we celebrate the conclusion of our expedition with a special slideshow and a final meal together.

Day 12: Disembarkation

With huge smiles on weary, content faces, we disembark in the morning, letting you catch a flight to Buenos Aires or stay in Ushuaia for more sights and adventure.

MS Seaventure is engineered specifically for Antarctica's demanding conditions, matching robust capability with an intimate small-ship atmosphere. Its 1-A Super ice class and advanced stabilisers allow confident navigation through rough seas and deeper into ice-packed regions that routinely limit larger vessels. All staterooms face outward, many with balconies, and the full wrap-around deck, outdoor dining areas and expansive windows ensure the Antarctic environment is always in view. Public spaces include multiple dining venues, a spacious presentation lounge, gym, sauna and dedicated science facilities, all configured for comfort, safety and constant connection to the landscape.

Design and operations prioritise responsible travel. The ship's modern systems reduce emissions, plastics and waste, while onboard practices--from recycled expedition jackets to efficient resource management--support ongoing environmental goals. Throughout the voyage, guests experience personalised service, casual luxury and direct engagement with the expedition team. The result is a platform built for deeper exploration: stable, capable, environmentally considered and deliberately sized to

deliver access, insight and an unbroken sense of immersion in Antarctica.


